## 2017 Fine Arts Competition

The junior high and high school students at HCS have the opportunity to participate in the North Carolina Christian School Association Fine Arts Competition. Areas of competition include large groups (e.g. choir, chorale) small groups (e.g. band, singing), and individuals (e.g. art, speech) categories. The competition is held in Raleigh, and it does not require an overnight stay. Our school is permitted two entries per category, except in the case of large groups.
