We are excited to continue the band and strings program at Hilltop Christian School. Learning a musical instrument is a skill that can be used for lifelong enjoyment. Learn more about our program below and contact us with any questions.

- The band program is available to students from 4th-12th grades.
- Lessons are 20-30 minutes and consist of individual and group instruction on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- The tuition is \$468 per year (\$52 a month for nine months) *A \$30 book fee is due with first payment.*
- You must provide your own instrument. Our band teacher can help facilitate instrument rentals. *We do not encourage purchasing instruments until you are confident your child will continue with musical instruction. Please consult with the band teacher before purchasing an instrument to ensure a quality instrument.*
- Instruments offered include: Brass (trumpet, trombone), Strings (cello, guitar, violin), Woodwinds (clarinet, flute, saxophone).
